

Re: FOI Request 1875/21 11-05-2021

Dear Mr Hawkins,

Thank you. I have read and filed the attachment and add it now - for the attention of my medically qualified colleagues who share my concern about the unnecessary inoculation of agents to do with the Covid_19 illness.

I understand the force's reasoning against release of the autopsy findings whilst a criminal investigation is in place. I read the news item of the 16th of April <<https://www.devon-cornwall.police.uk/News/NewsArticle.aspx?id=bd9546ab-bdd0-4cdf-866d-946f9fa422c0>> and ask now if an update is in the pipeline? The deaths of a total of 11 care home residents at one place, with 10 carers and one resident being admitted to the RD&E, has I am sure been cause for wide concern. It is omitted that I had acknowledged that the reports of the autopsies be anonymised for several reasons, including minimising the distress to relatives.

It is clear that the inoculations in many countries are causing adverse effects although the media outlets bar one in this country deny this, just as they have supported the HMG line of conflating the often faulty RT-PCR tests with 'cases'. You will know well that the BBC for instance has spoken of say 46,786 'cases' in one day, to keep the fear of death alive. I point you to the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency - MHRA and the logged adverse effects as gathered from the long existing 'Yellow Card' 'system'.

Quote "Report suspected side effects to medicines, vaccines or medical device and diagnostic adverse incidents used in coronavirus treatment to the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency to ensure safe and effective use" Coronavirus 'treatment' - is a misnomer. 'Prevention' is the appropriate word for the intention.

The lists are produced by an outsourced 'artificial intelligence' firm so irrelevant and incidental diagnoses are included. It is known that there is marked under reporting of adverse effects, and the Yellow Cards here in the UK is no 'system'.

I believe the public interest in these Holmesley Care Home deaths and the illness in the carers is of central public interest given the 'clustering' and the previous reports from say Callington - the Appleby Lodge Care Home, and one in Angelsey, plus others in East Devon.

I repeat my request. I ask in addition - have the criminal charges now been withdrawn?
